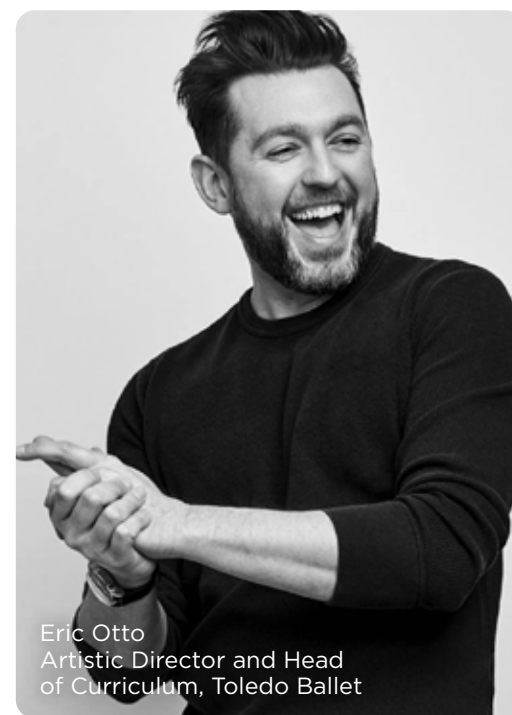

The program balances humor, warmth, and full-voice intensity, with a return to the music that first brought them together and a fresh take on the Phantom legacy.

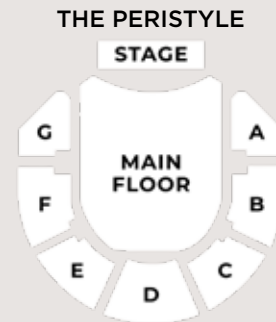

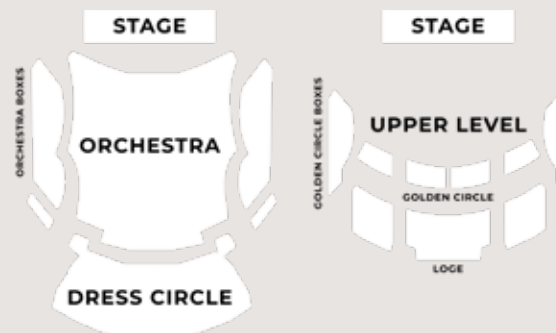
