

# GOOD TO KNOW!

## FOR YOU AND YOUR BUS DRIVERS:

Bus drivers will drop your students off in front of the Peristyle Theatre at Toledo Museum of Art, 2445 Monroe St. and pick you up on Art. Museum Dr. on the other side of the museum.




Do not leave the bus until a staff member checks you in *inside the bus*! We do this so we can have a smooth arrival and dismissal procedure.

If you are arriving for the 11:00AM show, you will not be allowed to inside until 10:40AM. The weather says that it will be sunny with a high of low 50's. This may be warm enough for your students to wait outside, but if it is too cold, you can wait inside your bus!

## HOMESCHOOL GROUPS:

Please feel free to park in one of Toledo Museum of Art's free parking lots and enter through the Carriage Doors which the hand is pointing to. You can walk straight to your chairs!



# Performance Day

## WHAT TO EXPECT ONCE I GET OFF THE BUS

Once you arrive, you'll be welcomed and ushered into the Peristyle Theatre by our friendly staff. They'll help guide you to your seats. Be sure to stay with your group and follow your teacher or chaperone's directions.

## WHAT DO I WEAR

There's no dress code for the performance. Some people like to dress up, while others come in casual clothes. It's totally up to you—just wear something that feels comfortable and appropriate for a special event.

## WHEN DO I CLAP

At the start of the concert, there will be a short announcement so you'll know when the performance is about to begin. You're welcome to clap at the beginning of the concert, after each musical piece, and of course, at the end to show your appreciation for the musicians.

## ETIQUETTE

During the performance, it's best to hold your applause until the end of each piece unless the conductor or performers signal otherwise. If you hear something you really love and want to share your excitement, you can quietly lean over and whisper to a neighbor, but be sure to keep your voice down so everyone can enjoy the music.

If you need to use the restroom, the best time to leave your seat is during the applause between pieces. This helps keep distractions to a minimum while the orchestra is playing.

## WHERE DO I GO AFTER THE CONCERT IS OVER

Once the concert ends, dismissal will be announced from the stage. Schools will be dismissed one at a time, based on where they are seated in the theater. We ask that all groups stay seated and patient during this process. When it's your turn, your group will be guided out of the theater. Outside, our friendly staff will be there to help you find your bus and make sure everyone gets back safely.
